Our priority at Aitken Creek Primary School is to meet the individual learning needs of all our students and to enhance their learning opportunities and achievements.

We operate within the Victorian Curriculum Framework with a strong emphasis on Literacy and Numeracy. We develop curiosity amongst students about the world they live in through our Challenge Based Learning inquiry framework.

We value respect, teamwork, achievement and being responsible. Our teachers and wellbeing team is focused on enabling children to be the best that they can be.

Our underlying philosophy is to facilitate lifelong development and growth of our students so they can achieve their full potential as individuals and as members of a healthy and productive community. Parents, students and staff are strongly encouraged to work together in partnership.



Current school facilities include forty eight classrooms, a full size gymnasium, three Performing Arts learning areas, library, canteen, three Visual Art/Technology areas and an administration area. In the main building, breakout flexible spaces connect the classrooms to enable open, flexible and personalised learning. Outside, the 3.5 hectare grounds allow for a mix of passive and active areas with hard court areas, a large oval, three playgrounds, landscaped garden areas and protected courtyards.

Information technology is available throughout the school and all children have access to mobile computing via wireless internet. Students are encouraged to be part of our Bring Your Own iPad program encouraging access to the latest digital learning opportunities. Students who do not own an iPad have the ability to access shared school devices. Enhancing the Bring Your Own iPad program are Apple TVs in every room.

We celebrate student talents and experiences through community events which include participation in the school musical, school concert, assembly performances, showcases of learning, art shows and school sports programs. Students have access to many extracurricular activities including excursions, instrumental music program and onsite clubs.

Early Learning Programs and Before and After School Care are available onsite through a partnership with the neighbouring YMCA.
